Shooters and Fishers Party Takes Aim at Jason Wood MP

Earlier this month, following the successful efforts of Jason Wood MP to have the import of Lion parts and trophies into Australia banned, Mr Wood received an aggressive letter from The Hon. Robert Borsak MLC, Member of the Legislative Council in NSW and representatives of the Shooters and Fishers Party.

In this letter, Mr Borsak MLC informs Jason that he “is looking forward to fielding candidates for the seat of La Trobe at the next Federal election”.

After making his opposition to Mr Wood’s pursuit of the canned hunting issue, Mr Borsak further goes on to explain that “[The Shooters and Fishers Party] will be directing [their] first preferences to the Australian Labor Party”.
