\$500,000 FOR HOLM PARK RESERVE CONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT

A re-elected Turnbull government will see funding for the construction and development of additional key features at the Holm Park Recreation Reserve at Beaconsfield in La Trobe.

Jason Wood MP, Federal member for La Trobe said the completion of new facilities at the Holm Park Recreation Reserve will assist in the development of three ovals, two pavilions, two netball courts, three multi-use courts (netball/tennis), a skate park, a sealed car park, family areas and supporting infrastructure to provide a full service to the local community.

“This \$500,000 is earmarked for the sealing of the carpark and building of a skate park.

“It’s great that Cardinia Shire are on board with this, and together we’re providing a central point for the community to gather and participate in sports, special events and general gatherings” Jason Wood said.

These projects will create and update a vital resource for the local community which can be shared by young people and families.

“The Beaconsfield Football Club and its supporters warmly welcome this election commitment by Jason Wood of \$500,000 towards our development. Our club continues to grow every day and we’re glad to see added facilities and other sports joining our ranks too,” said Gary Valentine, President of the Beaconsfield Football Club.

The skate park will provide a space for young people to meet in a safe environment, it will also provide the necessary car parking infrastructure needed for a reserve of size of the Holm Park Recreation Reserve.

At a cost total cost of \$1 Million, the \$500,000 grant will go a long way in providing this resource for the local community.
